



Jewell Family Dentistry Membership Program

Have you considered an alternative to dental insurance? Jewell Family Dentistry offers an annual membership program packed with benefits to fit your dental needs!

Members pay an annual fee of \$300 per adult OR \$250 per child with \$25 taken off each additional child in your family. Ex: child 1-\$250, child 2-\$225, child 3-\$200, etc. Adolescent fees are up to the age of 18. Children 3 and under– no membership fee with membership of family member.

Procedures included annually:

- 2 professional cleanings per year
- 2 clinical doctor exams per year
- 2 professional fluoride treatments per year
- 1 set of digital x-rays per year: for detection and diagnosis of tooth decay

Additional Benefits:

- Members save 20% on all additional procedures including cosmetic treatments.
- No monthly premiums, deductibles or annual maximums.
- No denials on treatment.
- No contracts to sign

All savings plan membership fees are due and payable in full at time of registration, cash or check only. Fees are non-refundable and remain for one full year. After 12 months benefits are null and void. Membership excludes patient from CareCredit eligibility at Jewell Family Dentistry. Plan benefits are not valid in conjunction with dental insurance or any other plans. 20% discount is not applicable to orthodontic treatment or treatment performed in any other office.

Traditional Insurance:

Dental insurance plans often come with a plethora of challenges including waiting periods, difficulty getting authorization for common and necessary treatments, alternate or “hidden” benefit limitations, costly monthly premiums and no coverage on elective or cosmetic treatments.

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Our membership:

You will pay one low annual fee. There are no waiting periods and treatment planning remains patient focused rather than benefit focused. There are no deductibles for members to meet and benefits do not run out once an annual maximum is met. Members receive 20% off non-preventative treatment with no “hidden” benefit limitations or denials.
